3. How to achieve outcomes that are cross-cutting

Joe Pidgeon

Joe Pidgeon discussed a proposed prioritisation of cross-cutting issues, being:

1. Voluntary Sector
2. Older people and vulnerable adults
3. Family and community cohesion.

It was proposed that place shielding (economic well-being) should be included as the first priority.
