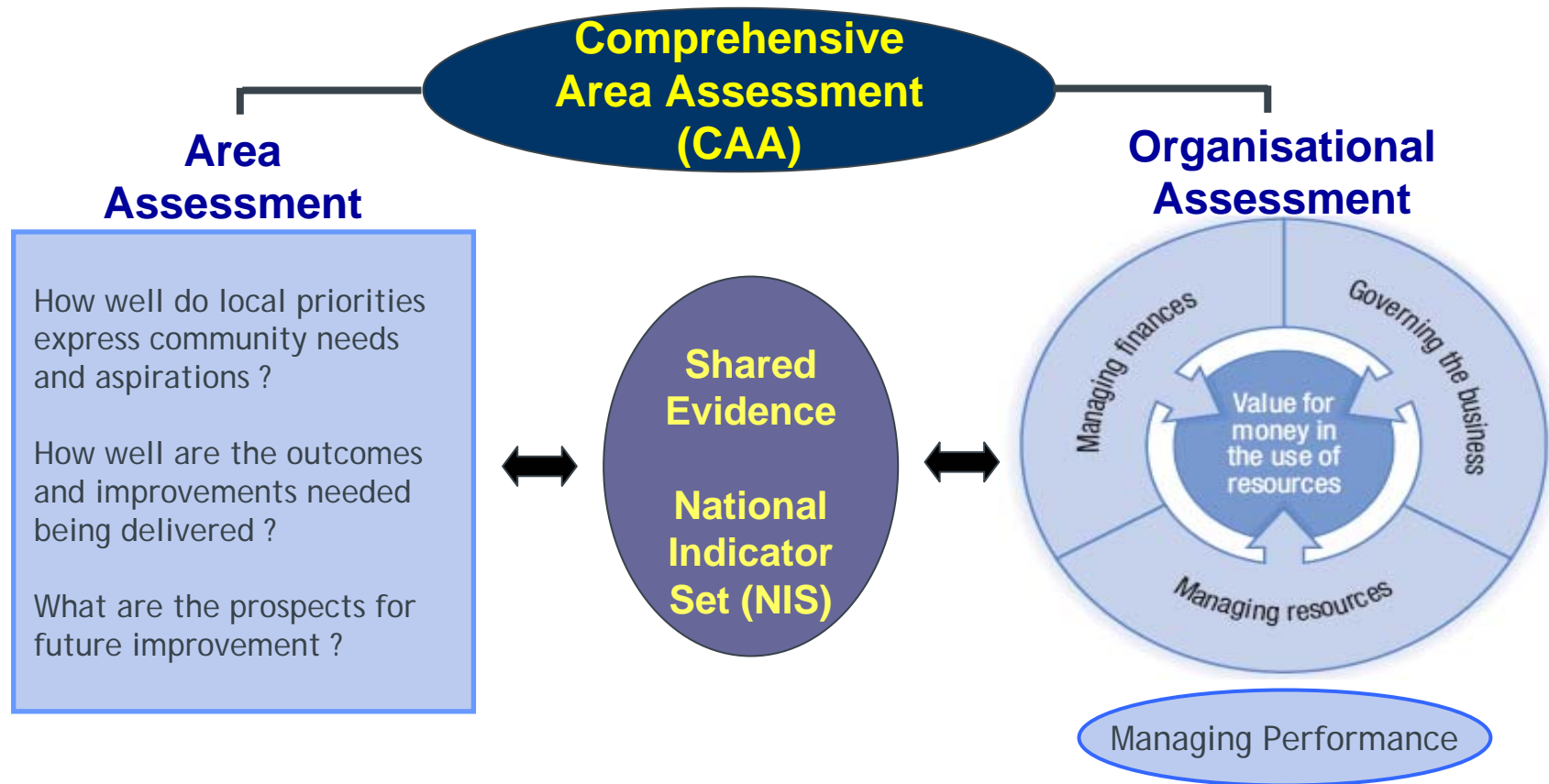

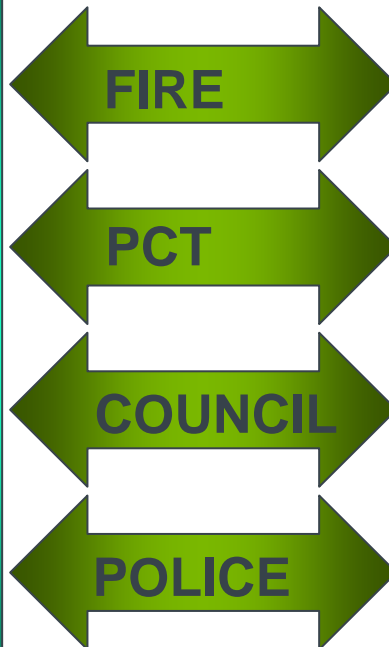
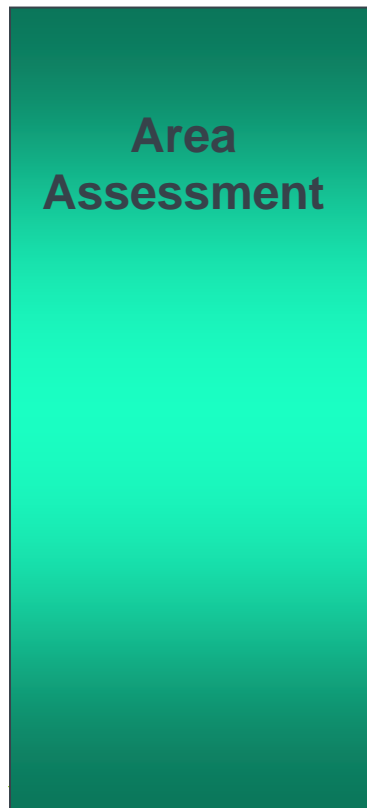


The CAA framework

Inspectorate response to red flag

- No additional inspection planned but key activities include:
 - Capability Review of Notts Police, Feb 2010
 - HMIC Police Report Card, March 2010
 - AC/HMIC Inspection of Notts Police Authority, July 2010 (dates TBC)
 - More structured monitoring of progress on crime & community safety by AC and HMIC – to inform area assessment
 - Feedback to Reference Group & LSP. On-going assessment of need for further inspection activity
 - Assessment of progress through area assessment and organisational assessments
